We feel connected to the Humboldt tragedy through Graysen Cameron (a crash survivor who graduated from OHS in 2017) and losing one of our own students, Ryan McBeath a few weeks before the crash. For these two reasons we felt it was fitting for our student body to donate the funds to another student body who has experienced what we have. All proceeds will be divided evenly among the nine schools. Each school will decide how they want to honor the student(s) they lost.

This will be a family-friendly event and grade 9 leadership students are hosting carnival games where participants can win tickets for a grand prize (some type of electronics or sports memorabilia). In addition please bring a pair of socks and try your hand at the Sock Toss. All socks will be donated to a homeless shelter. I spoke to Graysen and he is planning to attend the event.
