

Grade 9 Exam Schedule January 2018:

The following Provincial Achievement Tests are taking place during regularly scheduled class time and students will be excused from classes to write these provincial exams.

- K & E English Language Arts Part A Written Exam- 9:00 AM January 18th
- French Language Arts Part A Written Exam- 9:00 AM January 18th
- English Language Arts Part A Written Exam- 9:00 AM January 19th
- Part A Math- During scheduled math classes Monday, January 22nd

The last day of semester one classes is Monday January 22nd. During the exam week- January 23rd to January 30th, Grade 9 students are required to have completed the following obligations:

1. All assignments for all classes- both core classes and option classes must be finished.
2. The safety course, including all assignments and online courses, must be completed and a passing mark obtained.
3. Safety Project completed
4. Review booklets for core classes completed.

Ms. Toews, staff and I will keep students informed as to what assignments are missing over the next two weeks to ensure they are up-to-date before exam week begins.

If students have met all the obligations listed above, they will be required to come only to complete scheduled exams. They are more than welcome to use red quad as a study area and seek extra help from teachers during the exam period. **However, if students have not completed their responsibilities, they will be working with our staff in the red quad area to complete all assignments. The school day will begin at 8:45 and end at 3:15 until all work has been completed.**

There are no scheduled exams on Monday, January 29th and Tuesday, January 30th for grade 9 students but the staff will continue to work with any students who still have incomplete work.

January 31st is Semester Break Organizational Day; there is no school for students.

Semester 2 begins on Thursday, February 1st and student schedules will be distributed in Red Quad at 8:30. Even if students still have their schedules for second semester, they should pick up new schedules, as some changes have been made.
