

Grade 9 Exam Information June 2018

The following Provincial Achievement Tests are taking place during regularly scheduled class time and students will be excused from classes to write these provincial exams.

- K&E Math 9 8:45 a.m., Friday, June 15, 2018
- K&E Science 9 12:45 p.m., Friday, June 15, 2018
- Math 9 Part A 10:25 a.m., Tuesday, June 19, 2018
- Language Arts Part B 9 a.m., Wednesday, June 20, 2018

The last day of semester two classes is Thursday, June 21, 2018. During the exam week- June 22 to 28, 2018, Grade 9 students are required to have completed the following obligations:

1. All assignments for all classes- both core classes and option classes must be finished.
2. The safety course, including all assignments and online courses, must be completed and a passing mark obtained.
3. Safety Project completed
4. Review booklets for core classes completed.

Ms. Toews, OHS staff and I will keep students informed as to what assignments are missing over the next two weeks to ensure they are up-to-date before exam week begins.

If students have met all the obligations listed above, they will be required to come only to complete scheduled exams. They are more than welcome to use red quad as a study area and seek extra help from teachers during the exam period. **However, if students have not completed their responsibilities, they will be working with our staff in the red quad area to complete all assignments. The school day will begin at 8:45 a.m. and end at 3:15 p.m. until all work has been completed.**

- Science 9 (French) 9 a.m., Tuesday, June 26, 2018

There are no scheduled exams for grade 9 students on Wednesday, June 27, 2018 and Thursday, June 28, 2018 but the staff will continue to work with any students who still have incomplete work.
