Instructions for Completing the Olds High School Graduation Application/Career Consultation

1. Review your Detailed Academic Report and update your *Myblueprint* **high school** section and **post-secondary** sections at www.myblueprint.ca. Complete the surveys under the Who Am I section. You should have created an account in grade 9 and updated it in grade 10 and CALM. You must know your email for your account then you can use the “reset password” option.
 2. Update your current resume and bring a print copy to the career consultation.
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Olds High School requires the following:

To participate in the Olds High School Graduation Ceremony, a student must be registered in a minimum of 30 credits at OHS (not including courses enrolled in at Career High). The student must be enrolled in a program that will enable him/her to receive a high school diploma by June 30, 2017. To be eligible for the graduation list, students must complete this application form **AND** meet with Mrs. Statchuk for a career consultation before December 21, 2016. Parents are strongly encouraged to attend this consultation.

In order to qualify for the Olds High School graduation list, students enrolled in Career High courses must have two-thirds of the course completed by April 7, 2017.
