1. Set up a MyPass account and ***view credentials for a high school diploma.***
2. Create a SIAMS (Secure Identity & Access Management System) Account which will be used for Student Finance, Apply Alberta, Trade Secrets and applying for Rutherford Scholarships. Go to www.applyalberta.ca and choose apply now twice to access the SIAMS account setup. Be sure to record your username, password and security questions for future reference.
3. Log into your *Myblueprint* account [through](#) the CESD website Student and Parents, My Blueprint using your CESD email. Choose the "Forgot my Password" option if necessary. Complete the Learning Styles, Personality, Interests, Knowledge and Motivation Surveys under the ***Who Am I*** section and review your survey reports if you have not completed these surveys in grades 9-11. You can also redo the surveys as preferences change over time.
