### **Scholarship Update**

Reminder to grade 12 students to apply for the following local scholarships:

- Woodrow Judkins Scholarship deadline is Thursday, June 15, 3:30 pm to Mrs. Statchuk (you must apply this year even if you are not attending post secondary in the fall)
- Chinook's Edge Alberta Teachers Association Local #17 Scholarship (6 different scholarships: for students whose parent(s) are teachers in CESD; students attending university; and students attending college, fine arts, trades and technical schools) due September 15
- Murray and Inga Owens Scholarship for students pursuing study in nursing, occupational or speech therapy, EMT, CT, MRI, ultrasound or radiology. See Mrs. Statchuk for application forms.
- AON Consulting (for members of the Alberta Federated Gas-Cooperatives) due August 30
- Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) Scholarships handed out to all RAP students. Applications are due June 30.
