This commitment to safety as a priority is continually impressive to auditors and has resulted in the renewal of the coveted COR status (Certificate of Recognition), which greatly reduces Workers Compensation payments and elevates safety across the division.

This diligent attention to safety is practiced throughout Chinook's Edge every day, through detailed safety protocols and facility evaluations by our Safety Manager. We are proud to be recognized as a provincial leader in ensuring high expectations for safety because we care about the people in our facilities – our students, staff, parents, volunteers and guests. BAND FUNDRAISER


